- Initial objective to address areas "of chronic and acute unemployment"
- Transitioned to support for community rural economic development (CED) and small business growth
- Western Economic Diversification Canada (WD) is a Canadian federal department that works towards building strong, competitive and innovative businesses and communities in Western Canada. Portfolio Minister is Navdeep Singh Bains.

Why work with Community Futures?

- Explore ideas
- Obtain business advice no charge
- Bank said NO
- Bank said YES but only partially meets needs
- Poor credit history
- We are CHARACTER lenders
- We are not bound by the Bank Act for Loan to Value security issues
- Great track record in community



Basic Parameters of the Loan Program

- Maximum loan is \$150K.
- Manager's Discretionary loans \$10K and under approved by ED
- Loans \$10K to \$150K staff recommendation, approved by Committee
- For exceptional projects greater than \$150K we syndicate with other CFs
- We take security where possible, e.g. Personal Property Registry, Mortgage, Personal Guarantees, 3rd Party Guarantees (family)
- We need a business plan and cash flow projection
- Does the project make sense for the applicant, for the community?
- Interest rates higher than traditional lenders risk

*Rhiza, Greek in origin, refers to a root structure. Rhiza Capital is intent on growing local economies and healthy communities by connecting root capital to impact ventures.






Each year Sunshine Coast residents put millions of dollars into RRSPs and other investments. These funds leave the coast instead of supporting our economy and local business.


The Co-op pools membership funds and uses them to invest in local initiatives with a social return.

The Co-op finances local projects that create social and environmental impacts on the Sunshine Coast, while also providing a financial return to our members.

Since launch in November 2016, the Co-op has already attracted **31 investors, amassing over \$92,500**, which is invested in local projects with social and economic impacts.
